

STANDING ORDER NO:21/2019

Subject - Procedure for recruitment of sportspersons to the post of Constable in Rajasthan Police.

In supersession of earlier Standing Orders, the following instructions are issued to regulate recruitment of sportspersons under Rule-7(C) of RPSSR-1989, to the post of Constable in Rajasthan Police, to be undertaken by a Sports Selection Board constituted by the Director General of Police, Rajasthan, for the purpose.

The Director General of Police shall be at liberty to decide the allocation of seats and games as per the requirement of the organization, and also to re-allocate the seats in case of non-availability of suitable applicants, upon the recommendation of the committee constituted by the Chief Sports Officer, Rajasthan Police, for the purpose. The total allocation shall not exceed the total vacancies earmarked for recruitment under Sports quota.

There shall be 2% quota for outstanding sports persons, which shall be treated as horizontal reservation, and it shall be adjusted in the respective category to which the sports person belongs. In case any vacancy remains unfilled after the selection process, the vacancy shall not be carried forward but filled through the process of direct recruitment under the rules.

Only candidates who are bonafide residents of Rajasthan are eligible for recruitment under this quota.

This recruitment will be governed by the latest Government circulars wherever applicable.

1. AGE & RELAXATION IN AGE:-

- (i) The candidate must have attained the age of 18 years and must not have attained the age of 23 years on the 1st day of January following the last date fixed for receipt of applications.
- (ii) The upper age limit shall be relaxed by:-
 - (a) 5 years in case of male candidates belonging to SC, ST, BC categories (Backward classes which include both OBC & MBC) and Sahariya category.
 - (b) 5 years in case of women (General category)
 - (c) 10 years in case of woman candidates belonging to SC, ST, BC, Saharia categories.
 - (d) 3 years in case of the candidates who are State Government employees or dependents of deceased Police officers/officials killed while discharging their duties.
- (iii) The upper age limit shall be 42 years in case of ex-servicemen.

2. PHYSICAL FITNESS NORMS:-

Physical fitness norms shall be applicable as per rule 14 of RPSSR, 1989:-

Further relaxations in Physical fitness/ standards, as admissible, shall be governed by Rule 14 of RPSSR, 1989.

3. EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:-

Educational qualification required for the post of constable as mentioned in section I, II, III, IV and V of the Rules, will be as prescribed in column IV of schedule I of RPSSR, 1989.

Any candidate who has appeared in qualifying class examination is also eligible to apply for post of constable, as applicable, but shall have to furnish a certificate of having passed such examination on the day of document verification.

4. VENUE FOR DOCUMENT VERIFICATION AND TRIAL:-

The venue shall be intimated by the Director General of Police, Rajasthan.

5. INVITING OF APPLICATIONS:-

- The notification for inviting online applications for recruitment shall be published in the leading newspapers and police website www.police.rajasthan.gov.in.
- Candidate shall be required to submit the prescribed online application form through the common service centre (CSC)/E-mitra kiosks or at his/her own level after obtaining a token number from CSC/E-mitra kiosk. List of the CSC/ E-mitra kiosks and instructions for filing application form shall be available on website.

- (c) Handwritten application forms shall not be accepted by the Department.
- (d) On successful submission of online application form, a unique Application ID shall be allotted to the candidate.
- (e) Incomplete applications or applications not filled-up in accordance with the instructions issued shall be rejected under Rule 20 of RPSSR 1989. No claim for refund of fee shall be entertained.
- (f) The roll numbers for applications accepted online shall be allotted to the candidates on the basis of randomisation. Admission cards will not be sent to the candidates by post. It shall be the responsibility of the candidates to download their admission card by use of application ID from the website.

6. PROCEDURE FOR SELECTION:-

The candidates will be selected on the basis of marks given for their sports certificates and performance shown during the trial of the concerned sport/games.

(i) Certificate Evaluation:-

The marks for sports certificates shall be awarded as below:-

Note:-

- (a) Only the Merit/Participation Certificates obtained in games recognised by All India Police Sports Control Board, New Delhi will be entertained.
- (b) Only the Merit/Participation Certificates obtained in the competitions conducted by any of the following sports bodies in the games mentioned at point 1 above shall be entertained.

- (c) In addition to the above provision, it is clarified that only one certificate which carries maximum weightage will be entertained per candidate.

(ii) **Physical Standard Test (PST):-**

After the above, suitable candidates will be subjected to PST by the Sports Selection Board as per Point 2.

Height, chest/weight measurements will be communicated and explained to each and every candidate and their signatures taken.

Candidates failing to fulfil the prescribed physical standards shall be rejected.

Provision of Appeal in PST:

The Selection Board shall provide one chance of appeal to candidates who fail in the PST. A fee of Rs. 500/- shall be deposited by the candidate along with appeal application, and he/she shall be re-examined by the Selection Board on the same day. The Selection Board will be assisted by a Medical Board for the same, and the signature of the candidate shall be taken in all sheets with evaluation of physical standards.

(iii) **Trial (30 Marks):-**

The candidate shall be required to undergo trial for the game for which he/she is applying and will be assessed out of 30 marks. The trial shall be conducted with the advice and assistance of a Trial Committee, nominated by the Chief Sports Officer, Rajasthan Police, comprising of at least two NIS qualified coach and a renowned player of that game, not working in Rajasthan Police. The trial shall be conducted as per the rules for the sport established by the concerned National Sports Federation. The Trial Committee shall assess the performance of the applicant on every technicality of the discipline in which he / she is being assessed.

A. Individual Events:

The candidates of each sport will be required to compete against each other in their discipline (in their respective weight category, if any) and would be awarded marks as below, based on positions obtained in the trials –

- (a) Two marks will be deducted for every position after the 3rd position.
- (b) For games in which performance is judged on the basis of time /distance/weight/score/points the candidate must perform better or equal to the performance of sixth position of time/distance/weight/score/points achieved in the last All India Police Games.

Note:-If in case sufficient applicants are not available for a specific discipline to conduct the trial, the Selection Board may summon players of that discipline who have not applied for the same to participate in the trial, to facilitate the Trial Committee to assess the suitability of candidates.

B. Team Events :-

The trial shall be conducted by the Selection Board within the parameters of rules laid down for conduct of the sport/games by the concerned National Sports Federation.

The candidate shall be required to score at least 50% marks (15 Marks out of 30) in the trial, failing which he/she shall not be considered for selection.

7. MERIT LIST:-

Sports/ Games wise merit lists shall be prepared on the basis of total marks obtained by the candidates out of 100 marks.

Candidates who fail to secure minimum of 40 marks in overall assessment out of 100 marks, shall not be considered eligible for inclusion in the merit list.

Note :-

- (a) If only one player is available for the trial in a particular weight category in an individual event, it does not entitle him for selection. Sports Selection Board and Trial Committee will assess his calibre based on his sport techniques, skills and certificate evaluation, and award marks accordingly.
- (b) The basis of selection will not be the position obtained in the individual event of any weight category/other category, but the position obtained in the sports-wise merit list.
- (c) In case of non availability of suitable candidate in a particular event, those vacancies shall be filled from the merit list from reserve candidates in the merit list on the basis of marks attained by them in the overall merit list.

A combined merit list shall be prepared on the basis of total marks (certificate evaluation and trial) obtained by the candidate and the allotment of posts shall be done strictly as per merit cum preference basis.

The candidates who are 8th class passed but not 10th class passed, shall be considered for the posts in RAC/MBC Battalions only.

8. MEDICAL EXAMINATION: -

Immediately after the declaration of the select list, candidates whose names appear in the select list shall be required to undergo a Medical Test by a Government

Medical Board. The Appointing Authority shall move the Chief Medical and Health Officer/Principal Medical Officer concerned to detail one or more medical officers, as required, for this purpose.

Candidates who are found temporarily unfit and whose defect can be rectified within 6 months as per the opinion of the Medical Officer shall be eligible for appointment after the said period provided they are found fit by the Medical Board, on subsequent examination. Candidates who fail to conform to the prescribed standards of medical fitness even on re-examination within stipulated time shall be declared medically unfit for appointment and their candidature shall stand cancelled.

9. DOCUMENT VERIFICATION:-

The original certificates of date of birth, caste, education etc, shall be obtained from the candidates who are declared fit in the medical examination. These certificates shall be verified by the appointing authority and only those candidates whose documents are found genuine shall be eligible for appointment. After verification process is complete the original certificates will be returned and photo copy shall be retained by unit for record in service book. Entry of relaxation availed in height and chest measurements of SC/ST candidates should be made explicitly in their Service records.

Additionally, certificates of relevant sport and domicile will also be verified by the appointing authority.

10. CHARACTER VERIFICATION: -

Candidates will be required to furnish a declaration (Verification Roll) and the contents of such declaration, may be verified during the character verification. They should be briefed about the importance of giving right information. **Dates should be mentioned in every document of character verification.** Candidates with "satisfactory" character as per Rule-13 of Rajasthan Police Subordinate Service Rule 1989, as amended time to time, shall be eligible for appointment.

Matters, related to disqualification due to incomplete information/ fraudulent documents etc., relating to character verification, shall be referred for decision to the Police Headquarters.

Norms prevalent at the time of conduct of character verification shall be applicable in deciding suitability of a candidate for appointment.

11. NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATES:-

Candidate already working with Govt. of India / State Govt. / Public Sector Organisations will be required to submit a No Objection Certificate from the concerned employer, at the time of Trials.

12. DETERMINATION OF SENIORITY:-

(i) The candidates recruited under this process shall be treated junior to recruitment made otherwise under the Rules for the same year.

(ii) Amongst the candidates recruited under this Rule, seniority will be decided on the basis of marks obtained in overall assessment, i.e. out of 100 marks. If two or more candidates obtain equal marks, the person older in age shall be placed higher; where two or more persons have same marks and age, the person having higher educational qualifications will be placed higher; where two or more persons have same marks, age and educational qualifications, their names shall be placed in English alphabetical order in the Seniority list.

Candidates standing higher in merit shall be eligible for appointment subject to the provisions of Rajasthan Police Subordinate Service Rules, 1989.

In case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Saharia, relaxation in physical measurements is available only if candidates fulfilling the prescribed measurements are not available. The Selection Board shall take care to segregate the candidates who have taken relaxation of physical measurements and those who have not. When such candidates are included in the select list, they will find place below the candidates who have not availed themselves of any relaxation.

Note: -

Selected personnel may be stationed at one location for practice/ preparation for State/National level events for any period as decided by the Chief Sports officer of Rajasthan Police with the permission of Director General of Police.

After selection of the candidates the Board will allot them to various units as per vacancies by organising counselling session and shall forward the select list with recommendations of the board to DGP office giving details of their categories etc. Final orders of allotment to various units will be issued by DGP office.

13. APPOINTMENT: -

Medically fit candidates, whose documents are found genuine and against whom nothing adverse has come to notice on verification of their character, shall be appointed strictly on the basis of their merit, on probation.

Upon selection the candidate shall be required to furnish a bond as deemed fit by the Appointing Authority.

If a candidate is disqualified on any ground or fails to join by the date given by the appointing authority, the candidate next in the merit list, in the order of merit, shall be eligible for appointment.

14. DISQUALIFICATION FOR APPOINTMENT:-

A candidate shall be disqualified for appointment if his candidature is found violative of RPSSR 1989.

Any candidate who is found to be guilty of impersonation or submitting fabricated documents, documents which have been tampered with, suppressing material information e.g. concealing information about criminal cases pending against him/her, using or attempting to use unfair means during the examination, otherwise resorting to any other irregular or improper means for obtaining admission in addition to rendering himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, will be debarred either permanently or for a specified period by the DGP, for admission to any examination to be held under the provisions of these Rules.


His/her conduct may also be reported to the State Government for similar action in respect of various services under the State Government.

Candidates who have furnished wrong or have suppressed any information including those related to criminal cases, pending or disposed, when the said information is sought by appointing authority, will not be eligible for appointment.
